ABSTRACT

This thesis aims to study on home worker protection and the legal effect concerning work to be carried at home by comparative study of convention and recommendations of International Labour Organization and Asian Laws in order to be guideline for amendment to the legal provision that concerning work to be carried at home in Thailand in order to be in efficiently law enforcement.

From the study found that Home Workers Protection Act B.E. 2553 (2010) which to be a law on home worker protection in Thailand while still can not widely and fairly protected home workers in all regions such as safety in working payment of home worker and social security welfare etc.

This thesis suggested that it should be amended the legal provision of home workers protection in order that the home workers in Thailand will be received the appropriate and fair protection according to the Convention of International Labour Organization and Asian Laws such as safety, remuneration and social insurance etc. because of work to be carried at home is a specific work that different from the workers who work in the workplace of the common employer in order to most effective for current situation for enforcement of work to carried at home in correctly and properly.
