

## ABSTRACT

This research aims to study the crime prevention duty performance of the police inspecting mobile units including studying factors affecting their duty performance, problems and obstacles facing their crime prevention duty.

All of the police officers working in the inspecting mobile units at Don Muang Metropolitan Police Station are samples for the study to answer the questionnaire prepared specially for this purpose. Documentary study is also done for relevant data. Data obtained were later analyzed statistically of percentage, mean, standard deviation and Chi-square.

Results of the study are briefly presented below:

The majority of samples are between 31-40 years old, with 3-5 years working experience in the mobile units, ranked mostly as sergeant, salary not more than 10,000 baht / month, completed high school or vocational certificate, married and wives having no outside jobs, etc. They know well about the area they inspects: people in the area co-operate well in their work; they are fair in dealing with people.

In hypothesis testing, no variables relate significantly to the efficiency in their duty performance of crime prevention.

Problems for this study are the inspecting mobile unit will rely on criminal laws more than offer knowledge in their duty performance; their experience in the work can be shared among the new comers and the old ones who are often paired together by the superiors; their results of duty performance therefore are not much different. The nature of inspecting work is more or less the same. Even with people's non co-operation, the efficiency of their work is not drastically different.
