

Research Title	A Development of Indicators Level of Self and Mutual Reliance According to the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy of Farmers in the Royal Project at the Huay Thon Watershed.
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This research used qualitative methodology. Aims to study problems and demand of farmers in the Royal Project at the Huay Thon watershed and development of indicators level of self and mutual reliance according to the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy of farmers in the Royal Project at the Huay Thon watershed. Total 21 villages by content analysis. Target groups include farmers, Government officials, community leaders and stakeholders. The data collection from the document, participatory observation, in-depth interviews, focus groups and workshop in the duration of 12 months.

The results are as follows:

The problems of farmers in the Royal Project at the Huay Thon watershed include: Price low productivity, low income, high cost, lacking support, lack of funding, public utility inconvenience, insect pests, lack of water, landless and flood. The demand of farmers in the Royal Project at the Huay Thon watershed include: Increase productivity, water for agriculture, there good seed, reduce the use of chemicals, growing organic vegetables and rice market in district.

Indicators level of self and mutual reliance according to the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy of farmers in the Royal Project at the Huay Thon watershed. The Sufficiency Economy Philosophy in the following seven elements.

Middle path: Level of self reliance there were nine indicators include: household accounting, savings, growing vegetables, conserve, reduce expenses, husbandry for consumption, rationality, organic fertilizer and creation of income. Level of mutual reliance were three indicators include: group activities, harmony and meetings.

Moderation: Level of self reliance there were eight indicators include: growing vegetables, savings, household accounting, husbandry for consumption, conserve, training basketry, planting of industrial crops and no debt. Level of mutual reliance were three indicators include: group activities, revolving funds and building of reservoirs.

Reasonableness: Level of self reliance there were 10 indicators include: household accounting, conserve, husbandry for consumption, growing vegetables, rationality, sufficiency, organic fertilizer, savings, intent on Dharma and environmental preservation. Level of mutual reliance were five indicators include: group activities, listening to others' reasons, benevolence, harmony and setting up of security.

Self-immunity: Level of self reliance there were seven indicators include: husbandry for consumption, household accounting, growing vegetables, planting of industrial crops, training basketry, reduce expenses and organic fertilizer. Level of mutual reliance were three indicators include: group activities, sufficient community and setting up of security.

Conditions of knowledge: Level of self reliance there were 10 indicators include: conserve, growing vegetables, sufficiency, mixed farming, household accounting, rationality, organic fertilizer, supplementary occupations, husbandry for consumption and search for knowledge. Level of mutual reliance were three indicators include: group activities, transfer of knowledge and sufficient community.

Conditions of morality: Level of self reliance there were eight indicators include: conserve, giving advice, holding on precepts, assistance to others, growing vegetables, surveillance on narcotics, honesty and no annoyance to others. Level of mutual reliance were five indicators include: mutual help, setting up of security, benevolence, holding on precepts and group activities.

Balance and sustainability: Level of self reliance there were 10 indicators include: planting of industrial crops, husbandry for consumption, growing vegetables, mixed farming, planting crops to eat, household accounting, rationality, abstinence from vices, sufficiency and creation of income. Level of mutual reliance were five indicators include: group activities, setting up the village rules, surveillance on narcotics, strong leadership and harmony.
