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ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research was to study the relationships between the adoption of Vocational Education Reformation Case study Technical College to be teaching in Bachelor degree Major in Mechanical. Variables studied were teacher socioeconomic characteristics, psychology and perception of organization characteristics of factors related to to the adoption of Vocational Education Reformation . The samples were 434 technical college teachers. The research instrument was a questionnaire. The data analyzed by percentage, arithmetic mean, standard deviation, Pearson product moment correlation, Spearman rank correlation and canonical correlation.

The research results indicated as follows : Canonical analysis , in knowledge phase, persuasion phase, decision phase, implementation phase and confirmation phase, there were relationships between independent variables and dependent variables : 47.1, 8.0, 4.8, 3.2 and 1.1. In addition, revealed the 5 variables related to adoption of Vocational Education Reformation of technical college teachers were age, educational level, knowledge, Vocational Education Reformation information and organization characteristics.
