

Research Title	Environmental and heritage conservation of large street tree in Bangkok
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Abstract

This study aimed to survey of large street trees and study environmental and heritage conservation.

The results of the study are 5 large street trees for survey are *Plerocarpus indicus* (55.13%), *Lagerstroemia macrocarpa* Wall. (19.34%), *Swietenia macrophylla* King. (18.80%), *Delonix regia* (Bojer) Raf. (3.95%) and *Lagerstroemia floribunda* Jack Share (2.78%). In Pranakorn district are 5 large street trees for survey are *Tamarindus indica* Linn. (66.67%), *Lagerstroemia macrocarpa* Wall. (15.97%), *Cassia fistula* L. (7.64%), *Plerocarpus indicus* (7.64%) and *Swietenia macrophylla* King. (2.08%) and Sampanthawong district are 5 large street trees for survey are *Swietenia macrophylla* King. (56.73%), *Plerocarpus Indicus* (23.08%), *Polyalthia longifolia* Benth Hook.f.ver. *Pandurata* (15.38%), *Tabebuia rosea* (Bertol.) DC. (2.88%) and *Artocarpus heterophyllus* Lam. (1.92%) and the results of the study for geographic information system.
