The objective of study were to study of young children rearing culture Lu Mien Tribes. By using purposive sampling technique, 65 people were selected including 20 experts and 45 parents of young children. The research instrument included in-depth interview non-interview participate observation and non-participate observation. The study is part of quality research and the results indicated that:

1. On the physicality and general information: The Lu Mien people's physicalities, Society and economy changed based on generation cycles moreover, In frastrastuce, technology and children's development centers played. An important role in raising the children, especially the in fluence of new Knowledge regarding children's development. This had relieved some burden from parents.

2. Culture, traditions, spiritual activities, beliefs were involed and engaged play of marriage and having children were set if health conditions and financial readiness were met. All of the aforementioned aspects had been passed on from the older generations to present. However, certain beliefs such as how to eare for new burns have been relaxed more than in the past.

3. Regarding the roles of parents and parenting, mothers assumed the role rasing developing and parenting children while father's main duty was to support the families and other members of families and siblings also lent helping hands in taking care of children. Hence, no specific techniques or methods were used when raising children, Every thing is based on each famicy's condition and local community.

For the first child prerence, The Lu Miens paefered to have a boy in order to continue to carry on with the root and expectation was high for the child to be a good and capable person. He also expected to preserve and continued with the Lu Miens culture and traditions.
