Based on the analysis of external factors of the community regarding the management of upland rice of the community by SWOT Analysis, the community has strengthened in rice cultivation culture and rice diversity. But the lack of knowledge management within the community and conservation of rice diversity. Including soil and water conservation for rice cultivation. Therefore the management of upland rice in the rice bank form should be done in the form of a community board appointed by members of the community. Regulation of membership requirements. Appropriate cultural, lifestyle and economic conditions of the community. And to strengthen and sustain the community leaders. The directors of the rice rank board should be learning process based on rice management, rice culture natural resources in order for the community to be self-reliant and adapted to change in every dimension.
