

<b>Title</b>	The Study of Expectation and Satisfaction among Student's on Suan Dusit Rajabhat University: A Case Study of Saraburi Campus

The purpose of this exploratory research was to study and compare expectation and satisfaction of the students at Suan Dusit Rajabhat University. The surveyed educational environment consisted of four aspects, covering school buildings and premises, instructional management, students' activities, and peer-group environment.

The population of this research was the students studying at the second year to fourth year at Saraburi Education Center, Suan Dusit Rajabhat University. There were 100 sample selected by a multi-stage sampling. The instrument used for data collection was questionnaire.

The findings revealed that overall expectation of the students on educational environment was at a high level. Considering each aspect, the expectation on peer-group ranked the highest level, followed by instructional management, students' activities, and buildings and premises respectively. In terms of satisfaction, overall satisfaction of the students towards educational environment was at a low level. It was found that the satisfaction towards peer-group ranked the highest level, followed by instructional management, students' activities, and buildings and premises respectively.

The result of hypothesis testing showed that overall expectation of the students before attending the university was different from the satisfaction after attending the university at the statistical significance of 0.05. The expectation before attending the university was higher than the satisfaction after attending. Considering each aspect, the expectation of the students before attending the university was different from the satisfaction after attending the university at the statistical significance of 0.05. It was also found that the expectation of the students before attending the university was higher than the satisfaction after attending in every aspect.
